Good afternoon sixth grade parents,

This is an exciting time of the year at Mooresville Middle School as we begin to prepare current sixth graders for the transition to seventh grade. Sixth grade parents *and students* are invited to attend a Rising Seventh Grade Informational Night on April 4, 2017 at Mooresville Middle School. The Rising Seventh Grade Informational Night will begin at 6:30pm and will conclude by 7:30pm.

Any student who is interested in joining the Mooresville Middle School Band in seventh grade should plan to attend the Rising Seventh Grade Informational Night from either 5:30-7:30 or from 6:30-8:30 (come an hour early, or stay an hour late). During this additional hour, Mr. Gudger and Mr. Mills will help sixth graders determine which instrument they will play in the band. Students do not need to bring an instrument, and no prior experience is required. Come join the band!

On April 5, 2017, school counselors and administrators will visit sixth grade classrooms during the school day to introduce sixth graders to the online course request process. All sixth graders will come home with written instructions and descriptions of electives on April 5 so that parents can have input on their child's course requests. Online registration will stay open until April 11 so that families can have valuable discussions at home and make informed decisions for the 2017-2018 academic year.

Placement in Honors Language Arts and Honors Math 7 will occur after the school year ends and End of Grade scores are available.

Schedules will be created over the summer and will be available for students in August, 2017.
